- To foster a spirit of pride in the region.
- To foster a 'good neighbour' and 'good citizen' ethos in the region.
- To establish and maintain a club of non-political character for Members to meet through regular lunches and social activities.



Since 1995 the North Harbour Club has awarded more than \$3,000,000 in AIMES, Emerging Talent or Scholarship Awards to approximately 400 North Harbour youth to assist them in their pursuit of excellence in The Arts, Innovation (Science & Technology), Music, Education, Sport; and Service to the Community.

Many of our winners have gone on to proudly represent North Harbour and New Zealand on the world stage. They also give back to the North Harbour Club in many ways including attending and speaking at events, donating items for fundraising, and performing.

























BENEFITS OF MEMBERSHIP

TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP

There are three categories of membership of the North Harbour Club. These are outlined below and are designed to provide the best option for you, your organisation and your situation.

The annual membership period is aligned to the financial year (1 April - 31 March), however applications are welcome at any time during the year.

INDIVIDUAL/STANDARD MEMBERSHIP:

Membership is held by the individual and a standard annual membership fee applies. Tickets to all events and activities are booked and paid for additionally.

CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP:

Corporate membership provides the opportunity for two people from the same organisation to be recognised as members of the Club. This option includes individual membership fee for up to two members along with 10 x tickets for the Lexus of North Shore Lunches (5 per lunch).

Note: additional members are welcome to join the corporate membership at the additional cost of a standard individual membership.

NEXT GEN MEMBERSHIP:

Next Gen membership provides a pathway for younger members of the North Harbour Community to be introduced, involved and immersed in the Club, our members and all of our events. They have a great networking and social programme going on, with special events that the Club also put on for them to mix and mingle. Next Gen members are aged 40 years and under..

Membership is held by the individual and a standard annual membership fee applies (*maximum three years before becoming a standard member). Tickets to some Next Gen events are complimentary for members, whilst other events and activities are booked and paid for additionally.

CRITERIA FOR MEMBERSHIP

To be a member of the North Harbour Club you need to:-

- Be a North Harbour resident, or have your primary business located in the North Harbour area, or be a sponsor for the North Harbour Club; and
- Be passionate about local affairs, business, education, sport and/or social development;
 and
- Be of good character with values and goals that align with those of the North Harbour Club and be nominated by two Club members*; and
- Commitment to be an active member of the North Harbour Club and support of the Club's goals, by way of regular attendance to Club events, donation of goods or services for charity auction and/or sponsorship of the North Harbour Club.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

We are delighted you are considering membership of the North Harbour Club. The very simple process for application is:-
