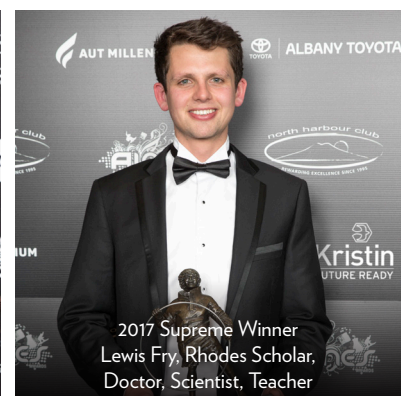

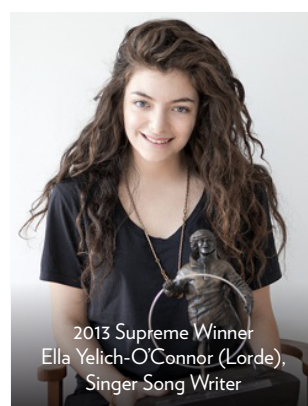

# TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP

There are five categories of membership of the North Harbour Club. These are outlined below and are designed to provide the best option for you, your organisation and your situation.

The annual membership period is aligned to the financial year (1 April – 31 March), however applications are welcome at any time during the year.

## CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP

Corporate membership provides the opportunity for two people from the same organisation to be recognised as members of the Club. This option includes individual membership fee for two members along with ten tickets for the Lexus of North Shore Lunches (five per lunch\*).

*Note: additional members are welcome to join the corporate membership at the additional cost of a standard individual membership.*

## PARTNER PLUS +

Includes membership for two individual members. Individuals can be from the same organisation, different businesses, or personal connections. This option includes four tickets for the Lexus of North Shore Lunches (two per lunch\*).

*\* Discounted tickets for Lexus of North Shore lunches apply to the first two events held annually. If a third lunch is scheduled, standard ticket pricing will apply.*

## INDIVIDUAL/STANDARD MEMBERSHIP

Membership is held by the individual and a standard annual membership fee applies. Tickets to all events and activities are booked and paid for additionally.

## NEXT GEN MEMBERSHIP

Next Gen membership provides a pathway for younger members of the North Harbour Community to be introduced, involved and immersed in the Club, our members and all of our events. There is a great networking and social programme going on, with special events for members to mix and mingle. Next Gen members are aged 40 years and under.

## AIMES ALUMNI

Quarter price membership to join for the first year, then Next Gen rates until 40 years old.

# CRITERIA FOR MEMBERSHIP

To be a member of the North Harbour Club you need to:

- Be a North Harbour resident, or have your primary business located in the North Harbour area, be a sponsor of the North Harbour Club, or have a strong affiliation with the region; and
- Be passionate about local affairs, business, education, sport and/or social development; and
- Be of good character with values of Excellence and goals that align with those of the North Harbour Club; and
- Commitment to be an active member of the North Harbour Club and support of the Club's goals, by way of regular attendance to Club events, donation of goods or services for charity auction and/or sponsorship of the North Harbour Club.

We are delighted you are considering membership of the North Harbour Club. The very simple process for application is:

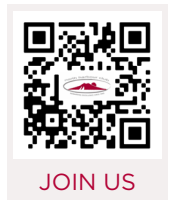
- Be nominated by two Club members\*.

CALENDAR
